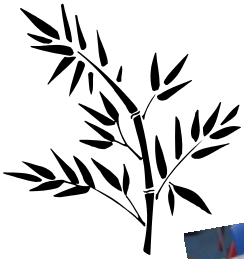


ANTI BULLYING WEEK
