



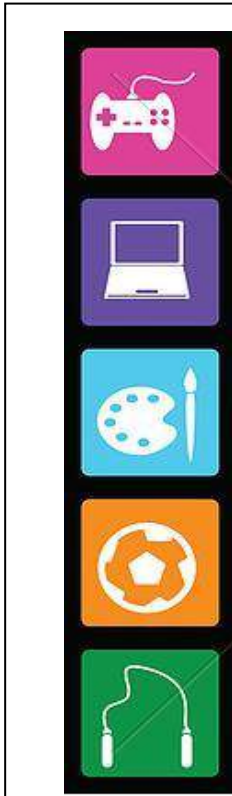
**Headteacher's drop-in session, every Friday 3pm-4pm**
