

Quality check your prayer

After each prayer ask yourself the following:

1. Was my wudhu done correctly? Were my clothes clean? ☐
2. Did I use miswak? ☐
3. Did I pray on time? ☐
4. Did I pronounce each word correctly? ☐
5. Were my movements and positions correct?
Was my body at a rest in each position? ☐
6. Did I focus during my prayer? ☐
7. Did I perform the Sunnah prayers? ☐
8. Did I read the dua's and dhikr after the prayer? ☐
9. Did I offer this prayer as if it was my last prayer? ☐
10. Did I seek Allah's forgiveness for shortcomings in my prayer and my life? ☐
11. Have I prayed for myself, my parents, my family, my neighbours, my friends and the whole Ummah? ☐
12. Did I approach the prayer with anticipation, love and fear of Allah? ☐

The first thing Allah will judge the people for on the Judgement Day is the prayer and ultimately Allah will decide if our prayer is accepted.

Use this simple checklist as a means to help improve the quality of your prayer. Set yourself a goal to complete all of the checklist, so that by Ramadan you have more quality in your prayer.
