English

<u>Firebird by Saviour Pirotta and Catherine Hyde</u>

Pupils will explore how traditions and cultures are embedded in writing. Pupils will make comparisons within the book and with other pieces of literature. There will be a focus on how sentence structure and presentation contribute to the captivating nature of the story. Pupils will be describing characters, settings and learning how to create different atmospheres based on mood. They will be integrating dialogue in their writing. The grammar sections covered will be using adverbials of time indicating degrees of possibility and using adverbs and suffixes.



The Lost Thing by Shaun Tan

Pupils will be identifying different types of figurative language in the text and evaluate how the author has used different styles of language.

Pupils will be practising spelling words with the 'ough' phoneme and learn to recognise and spell the suffixes cian/tion/ssion/sion. Pupils will research themes explored in the book to apply to their own independent writing.
