- Write simple fractions for example, half of 6 = 3.

English

Books: 'Tadpole's Promise by Jeanne Willis' and 'If All the World Were by Joseph Coelho'.

- Sentences with different forms: statement, question, exclamation, command.
- Add suffixes to spell longer words, including -ment, -ness.
- Writing for different purposes
- Writing about real events
- Re-reading to check that their writing makes sense and that verbs to indicate time are used correctly and consistently, including verbs in the continuous form.
